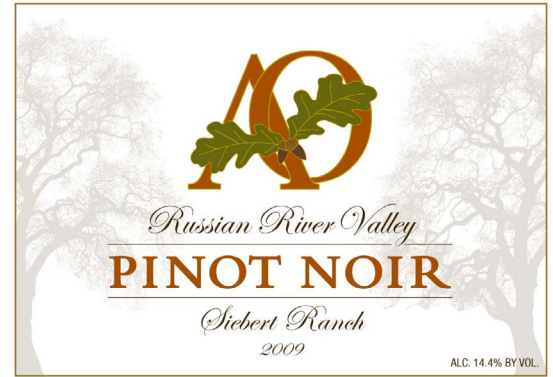

Inspired by the iconic oak tree presiding over the vineyard, Ancient Oak Cellars 2009 Siebert Ranch Pinot Noir contains a welcoming blend of ripe, sweet flavors combined with a fresh berry aroma.

Sustainable farming practices and family values are at the heart of the Ancient Oak Cellars Winery, located in the Russian River Valley. Nestled in the heart of picturesque Sonoma Valley, California, the Russian River Valley was named for the first non-natives to settle in the area. Its fertile volcanic soil and cooling fog from the Pacific Ocean support optimum full flavor and growth maturity within the grapes used to create Ancient Oak Cellars 2009 Siebert Ranch Pinot Noir.



Supported by his lovely wife and company president Melissa Moholt-Siebert, Ken Moholt-Siebert helped his grandpa Henry Siebert plant the first vines when Henry was 80. Winemaker Kent Barthman and vine tender Arnulfo Becerra are among the team of craftsmen behind the scenes at Ancient Oak Cellars Winery.

Hand-picked in 2009, the grapes used to create Ancient Oak Cellars Siebert Ranch Pinot Noir were cold-soaked and aged for 18 months in 100% French oak. Only 650 cases of wine were produced from this harvest.

Ancient Oak Cellars 2009 Siebert Ranch Pinot Noir is available at a relatively low price point of \$37. Encompassing a pleasantly silky texture with flavors of raspberries and cherries, Ancient Oak Cellars Siebert Ranch Pinot Noir 2009 is enhanced with background notes of espresso, toasted oak, chocolate and caramel. When paired with poached salmon, sharp cheeses, or bitter chocolate, selecting Ancient Oak Cellars 2009 Siebert Ranch Pinot Noir is sure to be pleasing to the palate.
